Guidelines for Himachal Khumb Vikas Yojna (HKVY) 2019-20

Guidelines- "Himachal Khumb Vikas Yojna"

Mushroom production in the country started as an experimental initiative in Solan in early sixties. With the creation of research base and necessary infrastructure at Solan, a small beginning was made with the support of progressive farmers around the centre. Subsequently, in mid 60s and early 70s, commercial farms were established in Kasauli, Chail and Srinagar. The success of pioneering commercial farms motivated other enterprising farmers to grow button mushroom under natural climatic conditions. Since the mid-seventies, mushroom is emerging as an important commercial crop in India for both domestic and foreign markets. The industry is gaining prominence on account of three main factors: ensuring higher/alternative income to rural people, creating more employment and earning foreign exchange. Mushroom cultivation has added advantage of efficient use of agricultural wastes as growing medium. Initially, mushroom cultivation was restricted to button variety, however situation has changed considerably in the last decade as wide range of mushrooms like Oyster, Milky, Shiitake and other specialty mushrooms like Reishi is also finding favour with the growers. Growing domestic and global demand coupled with relatively much higher returns per unit of land than other agricultural activities has prompted farmers and entrepreneurs to take up this activity. The rapid urbanization, increasing purchasing power and changing dietary habits have also helped in higher demand for mushroom.

Keeping in view the potential of mushroom to contribute to the state's economy in several ways including generating employment opportunity, additional income in rural area and its seemingly viable diversification option for the otherwise shrinking agricultural sector Government of Himachal Pradesh has launched a new scheme "Himachal Khumb Vikas Yojna" during the year 2019-20 with the following objectives:

Objectives of Scheme:

- 1. Women empowerment through technological interventions in the mushroom cultivation keeping in pace with the changing climate.
- 2. To introduce mushrooms as nutritive food for human consumption in mid-day meals, Govt. canteens, Civil hospitals etc.
- 3. Being indoor crop no effect of weather vagaries, wild animal/stray animal/monkey menace.
- 4. To generate sustainable livelihood opportunities in farming sector for unemployed youth of the state.
- 5. Providing technical & financial support to individual private growers/ groups in establishment of small/medium scale mushroom production & processing units.

Target at providing technical training to women, small, marginal and landless farmers, and rural youth.

7. To uplift the socio economic status of the farming community.

8. To make Himachal Pradesh as "Mushroom State of India.

Modalities of the Scheme.

1. Under this scheme, assistance will be provided to all category farmers of the State registered with department. Amongst these categories of farmers, preference will be given to the women farmers and physically disabled farmers.

2. Only Bonafide farmers of Himachal Pradesh shall be eligible for availing assistance under the scheme.

3. For seeking assistance under the scheme the beneficiaries shall fill up the application form on prescribed format enclosing the details regarding land holding /landless farmers.

4. The beneficiaries shall also have to fill up a bond regarding proper utilization of the subsidy of the required format.

5. The assistance shall be made available by the department subject to the availability of funds and satisfaction of the competent authority.

6. The subsidy claim should invariably comprise of the detailed inspection report of the concerned field officers of the department duly supported by the activity

7. The department reserves the right to accept or reject the proposal or restrict the approval to the project proposal subject to the availability of funds within the department. The decision of Director of Horticulture, Himachal Pradesh shall be final in this regard.
